Keyboard/Accompanist Residential Scholarship

To celebrate the purchase of a fine new Series 200 Overs grand piano, St Andrew's College is offering a scholarship to a keyboard player. This scholarship is open to both incoming and current residents (undergraduate, graduate and post graduate).

The scholarship will be in remission of $\frac{1}{4}$ (\$3000) college fees for 1 year.

Keyboard students with a strong interest in or studying accompanying are strongly encouraged to apply.

The successful applicant will undertake to assist the Director of Music at St Andrew's College and the Chapel Choral Ensemble and will be available to rehearse regularly and perform at chapel services held fortnightly throughout the year. They will take part in the Intercollege Performing Arts Challenge and other events as needed under the direction of the Director of Music, Chaplain and Principal. There are also an organ and a harpsichord available for use in College.

Interested applicants should reply in writing to St Andrew's College. No late applications can be accepted. Applications must include CV, academic record and at least one letter of recommendation. Auditions place in December of each year.

All Applicants will undertake a short audition including the following

- 2 pieces of their own choice (performed on piano, harpsichord or organ)
- Accompanists may choose to accompany another musician for their audition

Successful applicants are informed in January of each year.

Leave of absence from College duties must be requested in writing at least 1 week in advance to the Principal and Director of Music, otherwise scholarships may be jeopardised.

Auditions for scholarships are overseen by the Resident Director of Music (2008 – Adrian Chong), Senior Tutor, (Dr Wilson), Senior Fellow, (Professor Jack) and Chaplain, (Reverend Dr Jack).

All applicants must be either current or future St Andrew's College residents.
