Scott West Organ Scholarship 2017 (New Students)

In 2017 St Andrew's College is offering an Organ Scholarship to College residents. This scholarship is open to both incoming and current residents (undergraduate, graduate and postgraduate).

The scholarship will normally be up to \$2,000 as remission of College fees for one year. The scholarship will be paid in the form of fee relief on successful completion of the program at the end of each semester, and may be held in conjunction with other academic, bursaries or extra-curricular scholarships in 2017.

While the successful scholar may be studying any discipline, they will undertake to take an active leadership and performance role in the Chapel music program and other events as needed under the direction of the College Director of Music, Senior Fellow and Principal. The organ scholar will play for College chapel services and support the chapel choir.

Auditions will run on an as needed basis throughout second semester. Where possible we will arrange for your College interview for residency to be undertaken on the same day as the audition. Auditions will be overseen by the Vice Principal and Senior Fellow.

All applicants will undertake a short audition on the St Andrew's Chapel Organ. This audition will include 2 prepared pieces (up to 6 minutes in length), and some sight reading.

All applicants must complete both a St Andrew's College application for College admission and an application for the organ scholarship concurrently. Auditions will take place throughout second semester of 2016. These scholarships are competitive and you are encouraged to apply as early as possible.

By accepting the scholarship, students make a commitment to attend ALL events as required or the scholarship may be jeopardised.
