Instrumental Musician Scholarship 2017 (New Students)

In 2017 St Andrew's College is offering up to 8 scholarships for instrumental musicians. This scholarship is open to both incoming and current residents (undergraduate, graduate and postgraduate).

The scholarship will be \$1,500 in remission of College fees for one year. The scholarship will be paid in the form of fee relief on successful completion of the program at the end of each semester, and may be held in conjunction with other academic, bursaries or extra-curricular scholarships in 2017.

Keyboard students with a strong interest in or studying accompanying are strongly encouraged to apply for the Keyboard Accompanist Scholarship.

The successful applicants will undertake to assist the Director of Music at St Andrew's College and will be available to rehearse regularly and perform at Chapel services held approximately monthly during semester throughout the year. They will take part in the Intercollege Performing Arts Challenge, concerts and other events as needed under the direction of the Director of Music and Principal.

Interested applicants should reply in writing to St Andrew's College. Applications must include CV, academic record and at least one letter of recommendation. Auditions will run on an as needed basis throughout second semester. Where possible we will arrange for your College interview for residency to be undertaken on the same day as the audition.

Auditions will be overseen by the Director of Music, Vice Principal and Senior Fellow. All applicants will undertake a short audition including the following

- 2 pieces of their own choice
- sight reading

Leave of absence from College duties must be requested in writing at least 1 week in advance to the Director of Music, otherwise scholarship may be jeopardised.

All applicants must complete both a St Andrew's College application for admission and an application for the instrumental musician scholarship concurrently. Auditions will take place throughout second semester 2016. These scholarships are competitive and you are encouraged to apply as early as possible.
