Visual Art Scholars 2017 (Returning Students)

In 2017 St Andrew's College is offering 3 Visual Art Scholarships to College residents. These scholarships are open to both incoming and current residents (undergraduate, graduate and postgraduate). Visual arts includes, but is not limited to the following: ceramics, drawing, painting, sculpture, printmaking, design, crafts, photography, video, filmmaking, architecture, conceptual art, textile arts and other applied art media.

The scholarship will normally be up to \$1,000. The scholarship will be paid in the form of fee relief upon successful completion of the program at the end of each semester, and may be held in conjunction with other academic, bursaries or extra-curricular scholarships in 2017. If the successful applicant is non-residential, remuneration will be on a fee for service basis.

While the successful scholars may be studying any discipline, they will undertake to take an active role in the Intercollege Palladian Visual Arts Challenge and other projects as needed under the direction of the Vice Principal and Principal.

Interviews will run on an as needed basis throughout second semester. All Applicants will undertake a short interview and present their current portfolio. Auditions will be overseen by the Vice Principal and Senior Fellow.

Interviews will take place throughout second semester 2016. These scholarships are competitive and you are encouraged to apply as early as possible.

By accepting the scholarship, students make a commitment to engage in the visual arts life of the College or the scholarship may be jeopardised.
