

St Andrew's College Scholarship for Australian Indigenous Students

In 2024, St Andrew's College will have multiple scholarships available to support indigenous students who wish to study at university and live at St Andrew's College.

The College awards up to \$2 million in scholarships annually, and around half of our students receive at least one scholarship. Due to high demand, we encourage all prospective students to submit an application as soon as possible, alongside their application for College. - 1. The Indigenous scholarship is awarded for up to three years to Australian Indigenous students:
- Who will reside at St Andrew's College
- Who will study at a tertiary level
- Who would be unable to attend St Andrew's College without the scholarship
- 2. The scholarship for 2024 will be in the amount of up to \$12,500 and paid as fee relief, half for each semester unless the student is fully ABSTUDY eligible. In that case all fees may be covered by ABSTUDY and we will offer you a smaller scholarship to support with additional costs involving College.
- 3. Scholars are expected to maintain a full time load and a satisfactory academic progress.
- 4. The scholarship is for Indigenous Australians. Applicants are required to provide confirmation that they are of Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent. This can be in the form of a letter of identity from your local land council or other official Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander organisation, or statutory declaration. The Gadigal Centre also has applicants complete a "Proof of identity" confirmation.
